Conditions:

The Springport Student Farm Cooperative (SFC) agrees to plant, grow, harvest, and prepare vegetable shares to all CSA members throughout the growing season of June-mid-September. All SFC crops are grown with care by students from the Springport FFA program. It is possible that some crops will partially or wholly fail due to unforeseen weather conditions and/or pests. We commit to doing our best to compensate lost crops with available substitutions. The SFC will deliver CSA shares to the Springport Farm Stand in downtown Springport on Wednesdays and Saturdays.

Agreement:

I have read and understand the conditions above. I agree to pick up my produce on my scheduled day, or make alternative arrangements for my produce to be picked up. I understand that my weekly share will consist of an assortment of items, largely depending on the season, and available quantities. I understand that shares cannot be personalized, and that if I fail to pick up my produce at the allocated time, it will be considered surplus and donated to charity.
